Discussion on the need to appoint 2 additional election workers for the April 2, 2019 General Election. Motion by Steve, second by Bill to appoint Eileen Ritchie and Marilyn Woodworth to the Town of Glendale Election Workers. M.C..

Mr. Brueggeman has requested an extension to May 1 and Mr. Eckelberg has requested and extension to August 1 for the removal of their Junk Vehicles. Following discussion the board agreed to allow both parties an extension date of June 15, 2019 at 5:00PM CST at which time Mr. Brueggeman and Mr. Eckelberg are to be in compliance.

There was a discussion regarding internet access for the town shop. Raye reviewed the rates. Motion by Bill, second by Steve to purchase phone/hotspot thru US Cellular. M.C..

There was discussion on the current topic of clearing the road right-of-way throughout the township. The current goal was to begin clearing all of the road-right-of-ways to 33'. It was decided not to pursue this endeavor at this time as Woodworth and Zirk, majority, are not in
