TOWN of GLENDALE, MONROE COUNTY, WI Private Mailbox Replacement & Repair Policy

Purpose:

To set the criteria that determines when and how mailbox replacement or repair will be performed by the Town of Glendale, Monroe County, WI.

Justification:

Replacement of mailboxes with standard generic receptacles will occur only when the mailbox is actually hit by a township vehicle.

- Not burden all taxpayers of the Town of Glendale with the cost of replacing mailboxes that are damaged by flying snow and/or weakly constructed or in need of repair.
- Not burden all taxpayers of the Town of Glendale with the cost of replacing expensive (mainly decorative) mailboxes
- Maximize the use of tax dollars for the benefit of the entire township public.
- Provide landowners with a written policy when they have questions or are installing a new mailbox

Policy Criteria Considerations:

Only those mail receptacles that were in reasonably good condition and were properly located and installed in accordance with United States Postal Service standards, and which were damaged by actual physical contact with township snow removal equipment, will be considered for repair at public expense. To be considered for mailbox repair, the owner must contact the Town of Glendale Clerk and complete a damage report. The Board of Supervisors will review the report, evaluate the damage and respond as is determined appropriate, within the following terms:

- Who Caused Damage: Damage caused by highway workers or others.
- Type of Mailbox: Plastic and non-metal materials are not very durable in the winter due to brittleness
- Decorative Replacement: Best placement for decorative mailboxes (or any residential decorations) is outside the right-of-way.
- Winter Replacement: Frozen ground makes permanent repairs not possible until spring.
- Installation of Replacement or New Mailbox: Should the landowner wish to replace the mailbox themselves, they shall be required to follow the United States Postal Service standards.
