Discussion of the purchase of 550 Series Truck. The board discussed that there is a need for a RD Grant to assist in the purchase of this truck, based on the towns current financial state. Motion by Steve, second by Don to approve the purchase of a 550 Series Truck. Yahnke-Yes, Walz-Yes, Zirk-Yes. Motion Carried.

Discussion on hiring FT/PT help for summer. It was determined that the position would most likely be an as-needed position rather than Full time and/or Part time. It was determined that Logan would be in charge of duties for this position. Motion by Don, second by Steve, to seek part-time, as-needed help for a summer patrolman. M.C..

Discussion on replacing the Radio equipment for the trucks. There is an option to purchase or rent the equipment. There was a motion by Don, second by Steve to table this topic until further information is attained. M.C.. Logan will report on his findings at the April meeting.

Discussion on developing a damage policy as a result of Snow Plowing. Raye reported on information he had gotten from other entities and how they address this issue. Motion by

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Steve, second by Don to draft to a policy regarding replacement of mailboxes when damaged by the plows. M.C.. Cheryl will draft a copy and present it to the board at the April meeting for review and approval.

Clerk correspondence was reviewed. Cheryl is to get bids from F&M Bank of Kendall, Royal Bank and Farmers State Bank for a loan for the 550 Series Truck.

Logan reported on roads and repairs. Road Band signs have been put in place.

Lynette Vlasak was present to discuss the removal of trees on her property.
